Appointed by President Bush to the FDIC, Bair contributed to its expansion through the adoption of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and the Consumer Protection Act of 2010. After serving at the FDIC and being at the forefront of managing the US Financial Crisis, Bair became Chair of the Systemic Risk Council.
