About the speaker: Ben Bernanke acted as the Chairman of the Federal Reserve from 2006 to 2014. During his tenure at the Federal Reserve, Bernanke led the response to the US Financial Crisis. He has published widely in Economics and has most recently published his book *The Courage to Act: A Memoir of a Crisis and its Aftermath* that chronicles the response to the Great Recession. He was named Time magazine's "Person of the Year" in 2009 for his management of the US Financial Crisis. He earned a PhD in Economics from MIT in 1979 and was a Professor of Economics and Public Affairs at Princeton University. He is currently a Distinguished Fellow in residence at The Brookings Institution.
