The Application for Admission

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications for admission should be filed no later than **the second Friday in January**. Students are admitted for the Fall Quarter only, which usually begins the last week of September. Admission decisions are mailed by March 31. An offer of admission is valid only for the quarter awarded and cannot be deferred to a later quarter.

ADMISSION PREREQUISITES

A candidate for admission to the Doctoral Program must hold a bachelor's degree that is comparable in standard and content to a bachelor's degree from the University of California and from a college or university of fully recognized standing. No specific undergraduate degree is required. Neither an MBA nor another master's degree, nor prior business experience is an essential prerequisite for acceptance to the program.

The Ph.D. Program is intended for mature students who have demonstrated the intellectual capacity and commitment necessary to pursue a full-time academic schedule. Applications are welcome from individuals with prior studies in the social, behavioral and technological sciences or other academic fields, or from individuals who have previously attended schools of management. Students seeking managerial positions in business should pursue the MBA degree instead. To be considered for admission, an applicant must have maintained a minimum scholastic average of B in his or her undergraduate coursework or a B+ average in any prior graduate work. The Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) or the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) must be taken by candidates to either program. Applicants whose native language is not English also may be required to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).

In recent years admission has been offered to approximately one out of 20 applicants to the Ph.D. Program. Admission is predicated on a scholastic record of distinction (*in both undergraduate and any previous graduate studies*), GMAT or GRE score, recommendation letters, and, as outlined in the Statement of Purpose, an expressed interest in conducting individual, advanced research. No automatic cutoff points are applied (*beyond acceptance to the UCLA Graduate Division*) to such criteria as test scores, grades and reference letter ratings. All aspects of the applicant's file are considered in relation to one another; an

assessment of the student's total qualifications is made based on the faculty's evaluation of the applicant as a potential scholar. Typically, a student who is not clearly outstanding in at least one of the several criteria will not be offered admission.

Further information regarding prerequisites for international students or applicants who attended institutions outside the United States is given under "International Students" on page 42 of the Ph.D. catalog.

UCLA regulations state that an applicant may not concurrently file an application to more than one graduate program on the UCLA campus.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Please follow carefully all application instructions. We recommend filing as early as possible and providing complete documentation as specified.

Completed applications are transmitted to the appropriate academic unit by the Doctoral Office. Each unit makes a recommendation for or against acceptance of each applicant in accordance with its own criteria of excellence and desired levels of scholarly competence.

After reviewing all applicants' files, the Admissions Committee (*a subcommittee of the doctoral board*) meets and makes recommendations to the vice dean regarding each applicant. These recommendations are discussed with various academic units. The vice dean is charged with making final admission decisions.

Letters announcing recommendation for admission are sent to applicants by The Anderson School on or before March 31. Registration instructions and a formal notice of admission are sent separately by the UCLA Graduate Admissions Office.

UCLA GENERAL CATALOG

Prospective or entering students also should refer to the *UCLA General Catalog*, which contains a complete list of courses available at UCLA, registration information, and all the rules and regulations pertinent to progress toward an advanced degree. The catalog can be purchased for \$6.50 at the UCLA Store. INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS

Please read the following instructions carefully before submitting your completed application materials.

Give your full legal name rather than initials, abbreviations or nicknames. The name listed on the application forms should be used consistently in all official relations

with the university. International students who have more than one first name or surname should indicate the name they prefer to use, and should underline the surname for clarity. In the United States, the "surname" refers to the family or father's name; the "first" name is the one given at birth; and a "middle" name is given as a second name at birth.

Application to the Ph.D. Program

This application, along with your Statement of Purpose, will be used by Anderson School faculty to evaluate your candidacy for admission.

Please give the full, actual names of all schools you have attended and the titles of all diplomas or degrees you have earned. Do not translate, abbreviate or otherwise modify these names. Students from countries where the Roman alphabet is not used (*e.g., Japan, Korea, Russia*) should, however, also provide the names of all institutions in English.

Indicate on the application the major field area to which you are applying. Your file will be reviewed by faculty in that area. If you are applying to the international business and comparative management area, you must also declare a functional field of study. Functional fields available for the dual major are accounting; decisions, operations, and technology management; finance; human resources and organizational behavior; information systems; marketing; and policy.

Respond to the Self-Evaluation/Statement of Purpose section on separate paper.

Please put your name on each sheet and paper clip the sheets to the application.

Ph.D. Data Sheet

The data sheet is used by the UCLA Graduate Admissions Office and The Anderson School to process applications for admission to the university and to expedite registration materials once applicants are admitted. Please attach your application fee to this form.

The university is required to provide reports on the ethnic composition of the applicant population to various federal and state agencies. Therefore, applicants are requested to complete the ethnicity code. This information is confidential and used only for statistical purposes. You may decline to state your ethnic identity.

Applicant Address Labels

Please complete and return the applicant address labels. One label will be used to acknowledge receipt of the application for admission. Other labels will be used for future correspondence.

Application Fee

An application fee of \$60 must be submitted with each application. Please make checks or money orders payable to: Regents of the University of California. Applicants from outside the United States must remit the fee either by International Money Order or by a check drawn on a U.S. bank. If a check is written for you by someone else, please be sure your name appears on its face. DO NOT SEND CASH. Since the application fee is used to support the cost of processing, it is not refundable under any circumstance, regardless of the outcome or the date of filing.

College and University Transcripts

Two official copies of each transcript should be submitted with the application. Applicants who have attended institutions outside the United States should refer to the "International Students" section.

For each institution you attended, please type or clearly print your name, address and the institution name on the front of the envelopes provided for your transcripts. Send the transcript request form(s) contained in this booklet to your college or university registrar(s). The registrar will complete the transcript request form, attach two copies of your transcript, seal them in the envelope provided, sign his or her name on the line across the sealed flap, and return the envelope directly to you. If

you have attended more than two colleges or universities, you may use your own envelopes as long as they are signed by the registrar across the sealed flap.

If you are a university or college senior, do not wait for senior-year grades before submitting your application and transcript. Updated transcripts showing fall term grades should be sent to the Ph.D. Program Office as soon as they become available.

Recommendations

Three letters of recommendation are required. It is preferable that at least two of the letters come from faculty members who can attest to your academic ability and your research and teaching potential.

Please type or clearly print your name and address on the front of the envelopes provided for recommendations. Send one of the recommendation forms included in this booklet along with an envelope to each person from whom you request a recommendation. Recommendations written in letter form are acceptable but should address the questions asked on the recommendation forms.

Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) and Graduate Record Examination (GRE)

Both the GMAT and the GRE are administered by Educational Testing Service (ETS) and are given at various locations throughout the United States and around the world. In order for your file to be complete by the **January** deadline, you should take the GMAT or the GRE no later than December. Request that ETS send a copy of your scores directly to UCLA. The GMAT score should be sent in care of the MBA Program (*institutional code* R4837). The GRE score should be sent to UCLA (*institutional code* R4837, *departmental code* 4201).

INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

College and University Transcripts

International students currently attending a university in the United States may request

that the university provide two certified photocopies of its own transcript of the student's records and all transcripts submitted from non-U.S. institutions when the student applied for admission. Otherwise, applicants who have obtained degrees at institutions outside the United States should carefully read the following information.

An international student whose postsecondary education was completed outside the United States is expected to hold a degree from a university or university-level institution with an above-average scholarship. An applicant who holds a three-year Ordinary or Pass degree or who holds a professional diploma in, for example, accounting, business, librarianship, social work, physical education or health education, or a four-year degree, diploma or higher certificate from a technical, vocational or postsecondary specialized school should not apply for graduate admission. Membership in professional associations such as the Institute of Chartered Accountants or the Institute of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators does not in and of itself qualify one for graduate admission.

Please note that all records of academic studies from non-U.S. institutions must be official. Official records are defined as original documents issued by the institution which bear the actual signature of the registrar, not a photocopy, and the seal of the issuing institution. Do not send the original of an academic record that cannot be replaced; obtain a properly certified copy. Photocopies of original documents must be properly certified by the registrar or attested to by a judge or a magistrate. The designation of the attesting authority must be indicated with the office seal. Certification by a gazetted officer is not acceptable. If you have attended more than one institution, separate official records should be submitted by each institution.

Certified copies of the following original documents should be submitted:

1. Examination records (*all parts or semesters*) of all university-level work attempted, showing individual subjects with marks or grades and the maximum marks or grading scale
2. Degree diplomas, showing final class placement or grade, and month and year of award

Unless the institution issues academic records and diplomas in English, the official

records in their original language must be submitted with an authorized, complete and exact English translation.

Records should show dates of enrollment; subjects or courses taken and the units of credit or time allotted to each subject during each term or year; marks or ratings in each subject; and, if rank is determined, the student's rank in the total class or group. In all cases, the institutional grading scale or other standard of evaluation, including maximal passing and failing marks and the definition of the grades between them, should appear on official records or as an official attachment.

Evidence of conferral of all degrees, diplomas or professional titles must be submitted. This may be in the form of official certified copies of the actual diploma, entries on official records, or official statements from the granting institutions. In all cases, the statements must include the exact, original title of the degree and the date of its formal conferral (*month and year*). Certificates of completion of required courses or of degree examinations cannot be accepted as evidence that the degree was granted.

Records from French institutions should include original or certified copies of examination records and statements of conferral of degrees in French as issued by the institution and certified English translations. Specially prepared English versions of a French record are not acceptable. As applicable, examination records should show individual subjects, notes, coefficients, mentions, yearly averages and rank.

Records from German institutions should include copies of examination records (*Vorprüfung, Hauptprüfung, Staats-examen, etc.*), seminar certificates (*Scheine*), study book (*Studienbuch*), and degree certificates in the original German along with certified, complete and exact English translations. Holders of the Vordiplom, Zwischenprüfung or a diploma from a fachhochschule are not considered for graduate admission.

Taiwanese records must show numerical grades, not letter grades.

Students applying from a country where Excellent, Very Good, Good and Pass marks are given on examinations must present an academic record with at least a Very Good general rating.

Students from schools in the British tradition (*other than in Bangladesh, Burma, India,*

Nepal and Pakistan) must have completed an Honours degree in first or upper-second class. Three-year Ordinary or Pass degrees are not acceptable. When grades and course descriptions are not available, applicants must request two reports of academic progress from tutors or professors. Based on these reports, applications from students for whom at least an upper-second class is expected will be processed. If the expected class placement is below upper-second, applications will not be processed until the final class placement is submitted.

Students applying from Bangladesh, Burma, India, Nepal and Pakistan should present a master's degree awarded in first or high-second class. In the fields of architecture and engineering, however, students who achieve first-class placement for the bachelor's degree (*i.e., those who have passed four examinations in as many consecutive years beyond the Intermediate Examination or its equivalent*) also are considered for graduate admission.

English Language Requirements

Success in graduate study depends on the ability to comprehend, speak and write English well. The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and the UCLA English as a Second Language Placement Examination (ESLPE) are required of all applicants whose native language is not English and who have not completed two years of full-time study or received a degree at a college or university in the United States or another country where English is the spoken language.

The TOEFL, is a comprehensive test of English language skills. Together with the verbal section of the GRE or GMAT, it is used to determine whether an applicant is prepared to begin a graduate program conducted in English. To be considered for admission, an applicant must have a minimum TOEFL score of 580 (*or 220 on the computer version*). The TOEFL is administered at more than 90 testing centers throughout the world by Educational Testing Service. For an application and/or information, visit the web site at www.toefl.org or write to TOEFL/TWE and TSE Services, Box 6151, Princeton, NJ 08541-6151.

The ESLPE is an English diagnostic test that determines whether an individual will be required to include English courses as part of his or her graduate program. An admitted student who does not meet the exemption requirement must take this examination upon arrival at UCLA and before he or she is permitted to register.

No other English test may be substituted.

In order to be eligible for a teaching assistantship at UCLA, applicants whose first language is not English must take the Test of Spoken English (TSE) and pass it with a score of 200. The TSE is administered by Educational Testing Service at TOEFL centers worldwide.

Visa Procedures

International students may attend UCLA on either an F-1 or J-1 visa. Students who apply for an F-1 visa will be sent an I-20AB application form. F-1 visas may be obtained by all students qualified to pursue a full course of study at an academic institution authorized to admit international students.

Students who apply for a J-1 visa will be sent an IAP-66 application form. J-1 visas, providing Exchange Visitor status, are for students whose program of studies will be fully or partially funded by the U.S. government, their home government or an international organization.

Financial Statement for Students Seeking Non-Immigrant Visas

International applicants who need F-1 or J-1 visas must complete and return the "Financial Statement for Students Seeking Non-Immigrant Visas" with the application.

Before a Certificate of Eligibility (I-20AB or IAP-66) for a visa can be issued, U.S. immigration law requires UCLA to have secured documented evidence (*i.e., bank statements, letters of sponsorship*) that a student has adequate financial resources to study at UCLA.

The appropriate form to obtain the visa will be sent with the offer of admission from the UCLA Graduate Admissions Office only to admitted students who provide proof of adequate funds.

Either the I-20AB (F-1 visa) or the IAP-66 (J-1 visa), together with the admission letter and proof of adequate funds for study in the United States, should be presented to the U.S. Consulate in the student's home country to secure the appropriate visa. Students should enter the United States on one of these two visas. Visa status changes in the United States are seldom approved.

Financial Support and Expenses for Foreign Students

Foreign students beginning studies at UCLA must have sufficient money to cover required expenses and should not expect any financial

support from UCLA unless they have been officially notified in writing of such an award. Please note that it is not possible for anyone on a student visa to obtain off-campus employment at any time of the year. Spouses of F-1 visa holders (F-2) are not allowed to work under any circumstances.

Withdrawal of Application

If you decide to withdraw your application, please notify The Anderson School Doctoral Program Office as soon as possible.

Financial Aid

Major sources of financial aid available to Ph.D. students at The Anderson School include the following:

- Teaching and research assistantships
- Nonresident tuition waivers
- Stipends
- Registration fee waivers
- Restricted Graduate Division fellowships
- Financial aid based on need (*loans, work-study funds*)

A limited number of teaching and research assistantships, registration fee waivers, nonresident tuition waivers and stipends are awarded on a competitive basis by The Anderson School Doctoral Board Admissions Committee. Applicants should indicate on the application form the award(s) for which they wish to be considered. No other application is necessary.

Graduate Division fellowship recipients are nominated by the department. Please refer to page 43 of the Ph.D. catalog for a list of Graduate Division fellowships available to entering students and the eligibility requirements.

Financial aid based solely on need is available only to U.S. citizens and permanent residents. Financial aid awards include low-interest loans and work-study awards. Entering graduate students who wish to be considered for need-based financial aid should obtain a financial aid application from their local college's student aid office. UCLA prefers that students complete either a CSS or ACT need-analysis form. Students should submit the application by March 1 in order to ensure maximum funding. A detailed description of all the financial aid programs administered by the UCLA Financial Aid Office is provided in

the Financial Aid Handbook, mailed to all admitted students eligible for financial aid. The Financial Aid Office service counter is located at A-129J Murphy Hall. Call (310) 206-0400 for service hours.

UCLA uses a need-analysis system enacted by Congress to determine how much a family should be expected to provide toward educational costs. To determine a student's financial aid need, this expected contribution is subtracted from the estimated cost of education. That need is met with loans and work-study. Students who receive fellowships and other outside aid will have their loans and work-study replaced by these awards.

As defined by the U.S. Department of Education, the term "independent," when used with respect to a graduate student, means any individual who

Was born before January 1, 1975

Is an orphan or ward of the Court

Is a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States

Is a married individual who declares that he or she will not be claimed as a dependent for income tax purposes by his or her parents (*or guardian*) for the first calendar year of the award year

Has legal dependents other than a spouse
